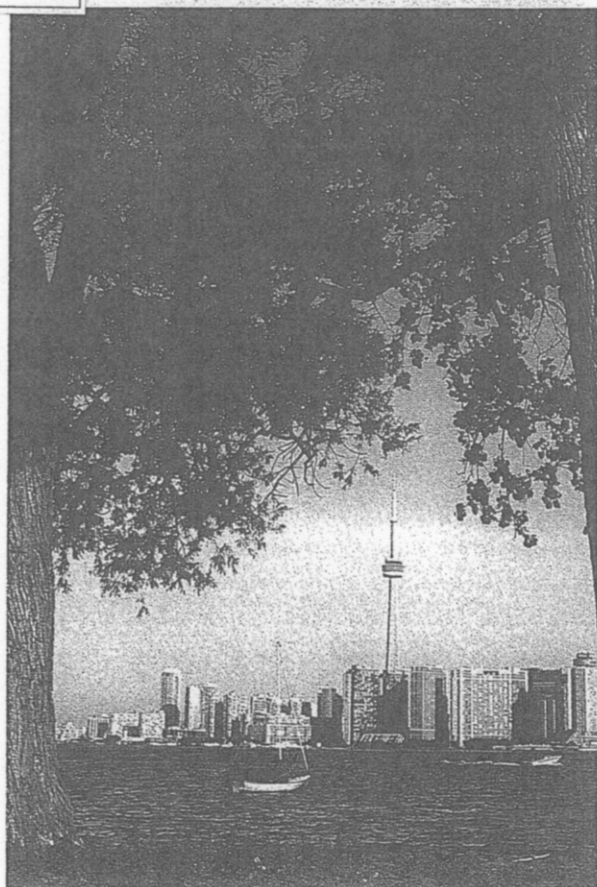
Canada Rocks!
