GREG Casper can run faster than a car.

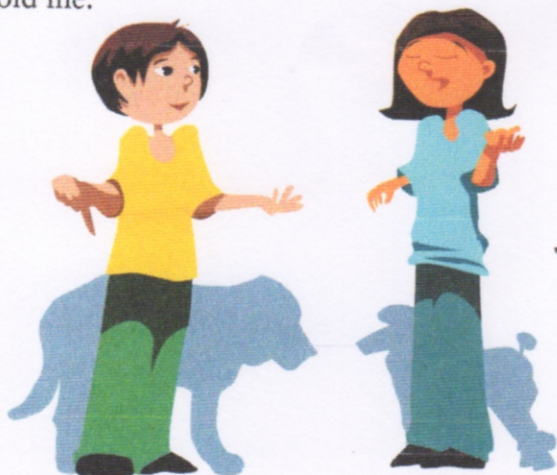
JULIE Really? Einstein runs faster than a train.
